We've done some fantastic work on 'Little Red Riding Hood' this week and we've converted our role play area into Grandma's cottage. The children have done some super 'hot seating' work this week where they've gone into character and answered questions as if they were that character. We had some very scary big, bad wolves!

Our new RE topic is 'Celebrating'. We spent a lot of time in our last RE topic discussing birthdays, so this term we're going to start off by looking at different celebrations such as weddings, Christmas, New Year etc. It would be great if you could support at home by looking at photographs of celebrations and discussing how and why people celebrate.

In Maths this term we've started off with the White Rose unit 'Alive in 5!' In this unit the children will be learning about zero, comparing numbers to 5, learning about composition of 4 and 5 and doing work on mass and capacity. Our maths lessons are always fun and practical and we take every opportunity to get the children counting, comparing, subitising and estimating.
