It's been another busy week in Reception class! We've had our daily phonics lessons where we've worked on 'v' and 'w' sounds and have practised blending and spelling. In our maths lessons we've been looking at composition of 4 and 5. We want the children to be really confident with number bonds and to understand that there are several different ways of making these numbers. We've also been comparing numbers using the words 'more' and 'fewer'

In RE we've continued our work on celebrations. We've role played celebrations, discussed celebrations we've enjoyed in the past and read lots of stories with a celebration theme.

We've continued looking at 'Little Red Riding Hood' this week. The children have all sequenced the story and retold the story in their own words. We've encouraged them to use story telling language like 'Once upon a time' and 'long ago'. We have some super little story tellers and we have thoroughly

enjoyed listening to their fantastic versions of 'Little Red Riding Hood' this week.

In PE we will be having some football training sessions for the next half term. A coach from SAFC is coming in to work with the children. We had lots of fun on Monday learning how to warm up like a footballer!

We're going to be learning about Chinese New Year next week so if you get the chance to discuss this with your child over the weekend, that would be fantastic.
