

Year 2 Spring term newsletter

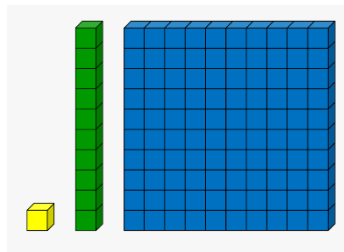
Year 2 have been working so hard this year. We have learned so much already!

In Autumn term, we worked hard in all subjects.

In English we began our first 'Talk for Writing' unit where we innovated the story of 'The Magic Porridge Pot.'



In Maths, we enjoyed learning about Place Value and Addition and Subtraction. We have been learning some formal methods to add and subtract. We use our concrete materials to support our learning.



This term in Maths, we are exploring shape. We have been looking at the properties of 2d and 3d shapes.

The children have particularly enjoyed our History lessons. We have been learning about the Queens of England. We have learned some very interesting facts. Ask your child what they can remember about this topic!
