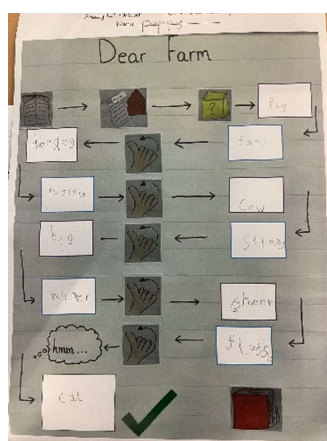
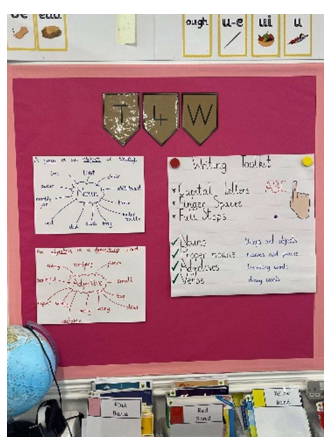
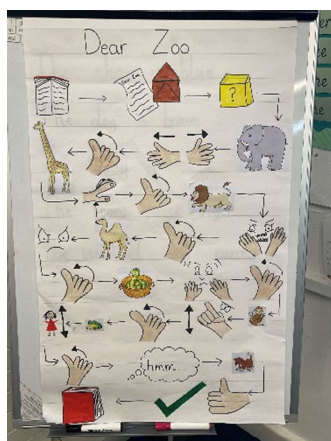


## Year One

#### Maths

In Maths, we have explored numbers to 10. We can use symbols to write number sentences. We have also used, ten frames, part-whole models and really enjoy using the manipulatives. We can name 2D and 3D shapes, and list some of their properties.
