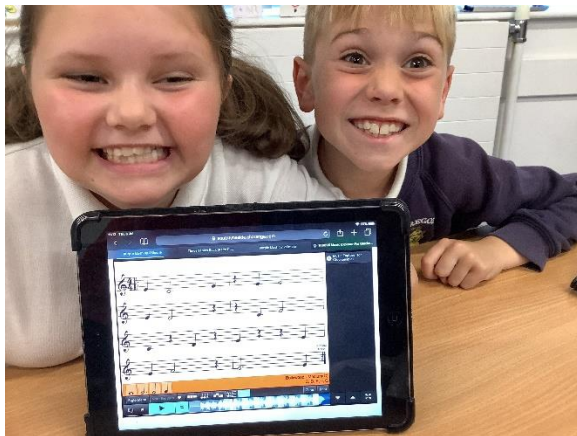
Art & DT
