We will be learning about "Me and my family" in the first half term and about the different celebrations such as Harvest which happen in Autumn.

We will also be learning about Autumn and observing the changes which happen in our world at this time of the year.

We may be having trips to Cleadon Park library, The Urban Factory and West Boldon Lodge in the first term.
