## **Little Stars @ St. Gregory’s**



We are so excited to be opening our Nursery class in September! Our spaces are filling up quick!

Many parents have been asking about the building work and when the Nursery will be constructed. I am pleased to share that we will be using our **existing building** to create the Nursery space — no new build is needed.

Currently, we have a large classroom being used as an ICT suite. This space will be **renovated over the summer holidays** and transformed into the new **Year 2 classroom**.

The **current Reception and Year 1 classrooms** will also be **refurbished** to create a wonderful new **Early Years area**, which will include both Nursery and Reception classes and benefit from access to outdoor space.

As part of these changes:

- The **Year 1 class will move into the renovated Year 2 classroom**.
- There will be **some changes to drop-off and collection points** for the affected classes — we’ll share full details before the start of term.
- We have purchased a whole class set of new laptops to ensure our children’s computing curriculum is still fully accessible.

This is a truly exciting time for St. Gregory’s. We believe the renovations and updates over the summer will make our school even better for all our children and families!
