PE

Spring Term learning in Nursery

RE: This term our R.E. work focuses upon three themes: Celebrating, Gathering and Growing. In 'Celebrating' we will learn that many different Celebrations take place in Church. In the 'Gathering' topic, we will learn about the joy of gathering to celebrate at Mass. In our final topic of the term, 'Growing', we will learn that Lent is a time to grow in love to be more like Jesus and we will look forward to Easter

Maths: This term we will learn about numbers 1-5. We will subitise sets and count with one-to-one correspondence. We will learn to recognise the numerals 1-5 and will start to learn about composition of these numbers.

English: This term we will continue with our pre-phonics work and will start to clap rhythmic patterns and clap the syllables in words, including our names. Our focus texts will be Fairy tales, and we will explore these tales through role play, joining in with fairy tale language and repeated refrains.

Art/ DT: We will paint Fairy tale pictures and make collages of Fairy tale settings such as castles and forests. We will make magic wands and character masks. We may even make and decorate gingerbread men!

Music: The children will make up and sing chants related to Fairytales. We will use the percussion instruments to create music to accompany the stories we read. We will listen to music and songs from different cultures.

Understanding the world: We will learn about different types of home and habitat. We will observe seasonal change and look for signs of Spring. We will plant seeds and watch as they grow.

Personal, Social, Emotional development: We will continue to work on being independent. Please help at home by encouraging your child to have a go at putting their own coat on, flushing the toilet etc. We will introduce all of our little ones to the St. Gregory's way and encourage them to be respectful, confident and resilient members of our school community.
